This involves the application of preservatives, fitting of equipment protection and suitable packaging prior to delivery (damage prevention). Monthly, joint self-verification checks are conducted and observations tracked and reported via our HSSE system to strengthen procedural discipline.

Upon receipt at our integrated operations facility, our warehouse preservation services ensure that materials/equipment are stored in accordance with OEM guidelines to prevent damage or deterioration while stored and/or prior to installation.
